

WE DID IT!

We are so pleased to announce that we have officially exceeded our 2024 target of providing vision screening to 12,000 children!

From these screenings, over 2200 children have been referred for further testing and follow up with an eye health professional.

This huge achievement is thanks to our team of almost 1000 qualified volunteer screeners from more than 380 Clubs across the country, as well as the many Clubs that have joined us in our mission to provide awareness of avoidable vison loss in adults and free vision screening for children.

A Message from the LEHP Chair

The importance of regular eye examinations cannot be overstated. **1 in 5 children** have a vision problem which such screenings can identify. As with most health problems the sooner it's identified and treated the greater the chance of success.

80% of a child's learning is acquired through their sight. The greater the problem the greater the barrier to a full education.

Frankie is now seeing clearly!



Three years ago, when Frankie was 5 years old, a screening team from Q2 conducted vision screening at her school. Her results came back as out of range, so the team referred her for an eye examination where she was prescribed glasses. This year the team returned to the school and were so pleased to meet Frankie again, now 8 years old. She told the team she likes wearing her glasses and they help her see clearly both at home and at school. Frankie's future is bright thanks to her vision issue being detected early through the Children's Vision Screening Program, allowing her to get treatment and improve her ability to learn, develop and thrive.

When did you last have your eyes tested?

As we age, vision changes. 90% of vision loss from conditions such as Glaucoma, Age Related Macular Degeneration and Diabetic Retinopathy is preventable if detected and treated early. **An eye examination every 2 years could save your sight.**
